

Curt Campbell – April 2024



Curtis (Curt) W. Campbell was born in Rochester, MN, in March of 1934. He lived on a farm south of Rochester in Simpson, MN, with parents Howard and Freeda. The family moved to Rochester in the late 1940s, where Curt finished high school in 1952.

Right out of high school, Curt joined the Ice Capades. He skated and traveled with the show for two years from coast to coast in the USA and Canada. He then joined the Air Force, serving three years at Elmendorf Air Force based in Anchorage, AK. After his time there, Curt went to the University of Florida, where he received an associate degree in Radiology. Immediately after that, he went to Duke and earned an associate degree in Nuclear Medicine.

Curt moved to Spokane, WA, in 1966, at which time he worked at Sacred Heart Hospital until his retirement. During his long retirement, he became involved in residential and commercial rental properties. Curt collected and enjoyed 1950's Studebaker cars, taking them to car shows throughout the USA and a few in Canada. Curt was preceded in death by brothers, Stanley and Richard, and sisters Dorothy Allen and Winnie Swiggum.

In Curt's words: "So I'm at the end of the trail – It's been a great journey with Christ in my life."
